

Key concepts




Identity wheel

Rubrics for Critical Thinking

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Identifying (understanding) problem / issue	I cannot explain what the problem / issue is about even with help from peer/teacher.	I can explain the problem / issue but cannot describe all of its elements without assistance.	I can easily explain what the problem / issue and can provide descriptions of all of its elements.
Reflecting	I cannot provide my own reflection on the issue. I cannot provide self-evaluation.	I can provide my own reflection but it is not complete and I need help from teacher / peer. I can offer self-evaluation but some elements are missing.	I can provide extensive personal reflection and self- evaluation stating clear evidence of all elements.
Offering alternatives	I cannot offer alternatives as the issue is unknown to me. I cannot relate it to other cultures or even my own.	I can offer an alternative but often it is often unclear. Often I cannot find examples in other cultures.	I can offer alternatives and link them to other cultural milieus.
