


Doodle - scheduling




- Makes scheduling easy and fast

Evernote – note-taking




AWW - online whiteboard

Skype – video calls




Zoom – video calls

Google drive – cloud storage




QR Codes - easy sharing




- □ Great for quick sharing just share as a picture

- Can be customized and prints in a friendly format
- □ The free version is more than enough for teachers

MindMeister – mind maps




Edmodo – educational platform




- Using the educational platform is completely free
- Looks very much like a social networking site so you can start using it immediately
- ☐ You can make groups for students or just have 1:1 spaces
- You can easily: create polls, quizzes, give out assignments with due dates, monitor progress, include parents, etc.

- Everything is ready to be used immediately (teacher + student versions of lessons)
- You can select materials based on topic, calendar (holidays), collections (e.g. health and safety lessons)
- There is a range of level from beginner to advanced
- Available for download: more than 2500 flashcards, more than 1000 lessons, themed resources, etc.




Trello – productivity tool
